Catch Title: Personal identifying information-definitions.

Subject: Personal identifying information data elements.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This bill amends the two definitions of personal identifying information in current law (identity theft statute and security breach notification statute) to include the same data elements in each as follows:
 - o Social security number;
 - o Driver's license number;
 - o Account number, credit card number or debit card number in combination with any security code, access code or password;
 - o Tribal identification card;
 - o Federal or state government issued identification card;
 - o Shared secrets or security tokens that are known to be used for data based authentication;
 - o A username or e-mail address, in combination with a password or security question and answer that would permit access to an online account;
 - o A birth or marriage certificate;
 - o Medical information;
 - o Health insurance information;
 - o Unique biometric data;
 - o An individual taxpayer identification number.
