Catch Title: Digital information privacy task force-reappropriation.

Subject: Digital information privacy task force staffing, reports and reappropriation of funds.

Summary/Major Elements:

- 2014 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 123, created a three-year task force to study digital information privacy. Funds were appropriated to the Legislative Service Office and the Governor's Office for payment for legislative and non-legislative task force members for the 2014 calendar year.
- This bill specifies the Legislative Service Office will staff the task force.
- This bill specifies the task force will report to the Joint Corporations, Elections and Political Subdivisions Interim Committee, the Joint Appropriations Committee and the Governor.
- This bill reappropriates any unexpended, unobligated amounts remaining from the appropriations under 2014 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 123, to the Legislative Service Office and the Governor's Office for payment for legislative and non-legislative task force members for the remainder of the task force's existence.

Comments:

- Requires a report: October 1, 2015 and October 1, 2016.
- Reappropriates funds to the LSO.

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
