**Catch Title:** Kevin's law.

**Subject:** Creates the lifesaver program which provides grants to counties for specified search and rescue.

**Summary/Major Elements:**

- This bill requires the Office of Homeland Security to administer a lifesaver program to provide grants to counties for search and rescue of a person suffering from Down syndrome, brain injuries, autism, Alzheimer's or other dementia related disorders.
- This bill specifies grants to any one (1) county shall not exceed \$25,000 of State funds in any calendar year.
- This bill limits the use of grant funds by a county to the startup costs associated with purchasing or contracting of emergency response kits or services.
- This bill appropriates \$125,000 for use by the Office of Homeland Security for the purpose of providing grants to counties under the lifesaver program.
