Catch Title: Funeral Services Practitioners Act-amendments.

Subject: Amends the Funeral Service Practitioners Act.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This Bill:
 - Expands the definition of “funeral director” to include operators of crematories and chemical disposition facilities, as well as funeral establishments.
 - Clarifies the distinction between licenses (which are issued to qualified operators of facilities) and permits (which are issued to qualified establishments).
 - Authorizes unlicensed employees to perform limited duties under supervision of a licensed funeral service practitioner.
 - Authorizes the Board of Funeral Service Practitioners to waive or extend completion of the certification program, on the grounds of hardship or difficulty in completing the certification program, for operators of crematory or chemical disposition facilities who are operating crematories under the direction of a funeral service practitioner or funeral director.
