Catch Title: Medical billing-provisional providers.

Subject: Billing of mental health services provided by a person holding a provisional license as a mental health professional

Summary/Major Elements:

- Existing law provides services provided by a licensed professional counselor, a licensed marriage and family therapist, a licensed addictions therapist or a licensed clinical social worker are authorized for billing under Medicaid.
- This bill specifies services provided by a person holding a provisional license as a mental health professional are authorized for Medicaid if done under the supervision of a licensed mental health professional.
- The bill provides a definition of “licensed mental health professional” as a licensed professional counselor, a licensed marriage and family therapist, a licensed addictions therapist or a licensed clinical social worker.
