Catch Title: Bighorn sheep relocation.

Subject: Relocation of bighorn sheep.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This bill authorizes the Game and Fish Department to relocate bighorn sheep if an action of the federal government would eliminate or suspend domestic sheep grazing in the Wyoming range of the Bridger-Teton National Forest.
- The bill is limited to relocation of the Darby Mountain big horn sheep herd from the Bridger-Teton National Forest boundaries.
