Catch Title: Expedited EMT licensing.

Subject: Amends conditional licensing of medical service personnel procedures and rulemaking authority of the division within the Department of Health responsible for licensing of emergency medical personnel.

Summary/Major Elements:

- Under current law, the Public Health Division within the Department of Health is responsible for licensing emergency medical personnel. The Division is required to obtain legislative approval before implementing any rules.
- This bill:
 - Eliminates the requirement that Division rules must be approved by the Legislature prior to being implemented;
 - Requires the Division to prescribe rules for the conditional licensing of emergency medical personnel;
 - Specifies requirements for the conditional licensing of emergency medical personnel;
 - Authorizes the Division to refuse to issue, or to revoke, a conditional license if a condition is discovered which would disqualify an applicant from licensure.
