11 The governor may release funds to the Medicaid program in the
12 department of health as necessary to keep specific bankrupt
13 adult developmental disability residential providers in
14 operation. The Medicaid program shall only expend funds under
15 this footnote after receiving advice from the attorney general
16 that the proposed expenditure complies with article 16, section
17 6 of the Wyoming constitution and other relevant provisions of

12 in the amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00).".
