12 provided in paragraph (b)(ii) of this
13 section".

15 Page 6-after line 11 Insert:

17 "(ii) From the amounts available as provided in
18 paragraph (a)(i) of this section, each city or town shall
19 receive amounts in accordance with a city and town revenue
20 challenged formula as provided in this paragraph. The revenue
21 challenged formula shall be calculated by the office of state
22 lands and investments as follows:

24 (A) Calculate the median amount received by
25 cities and towns on a per capita basis using amounts received
26 under this section and amounts distributed to each city and town
27 using the sales and use tax distributions to each county during
28 the odd-numbered fiscal year from the most recently completed
29 biennium, including distributions to each municipality within
30 that county, under W.S. 39-15-111 and 39-16-111, but excluding
31 the distribution exclusively to counties under W.S.
32 39-15-111(b)(iii) made from an amount equivalent to one percent
33 (1%) of the tax collected under W.S. 39-15-104 and excluding the
34 distribution exclusively to counties under W.S.
35 39-16-111(b)(iii) made from an amount equivalent to one percent
36 (1%) of the tax collected under W.S. 39-16-104;

38 (B) Determine each city or town that received a
39 per capita amount that is less than the median amount determined
40 under subparagraph (A) of this paragraph;

42 (C) For each city or town that received a per
43 capita amount that is less than the median amount as provided in

1 subparagraph (B) of this paragraph, determine the amount that
2 would be necessary to increase the per capita amount distributed
3 to that city or town to the median amount determined under
4 subparagraph (A) of this paragraph;

6 (D) Determine the amount to distribute to each
7 city or town that received an amount that is less than the
8 median amount determined under subparagraph (A) of this
9 paragraph by distributing the amount available under this
10 paragraph on a pro rata basis, up to the median amount, based on
11 the amounts determined under subparagraph (C) of this
