Page 9-After line 19 Insert:

"Section 7.

(a) The department of environmental quality shall provide assistance to the City of Rock Springs, Sweetwater County or any other appropriate governmental entity for development and submittal of applications to the federal office of surface mining for the Bitter Creek restoration project to receive funding under the abandoned mine reclamation program pursuant to the state implementation plan created by W.S. 35-11-1202.

(b) The department of environmental quality shall provide assistance to the City of Rock Springs, Sweetwater County or any other appropriate governmental entity for development and submittal of applications for the governor's consideration for funding of the Bitter Creek restoration project as provided by W.S. 35-11-1202(c).

(c) The department of environmental quality is authorized to submit a new grant application to the federal office of surface mining in an amount not to exceed one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000.00) from any unexpended, unobligated funds reverted from appropriations in section 2(a)(ii) and (iii) and section 4(a) of this act for the planning and design of segments two (2), three (3) and four (4) of the Bitter Creek restoration project near Rock Springs and for the construction segment one (1) of the Bitter Creek restoration project near Rock Springs. Any unexpended, unobligated funds from appropriations in section 2(a)(ii) and (iii) and section 4(a) of this act shall be reverted by notifying the department of environmental quality of the

unexpended, unobligated funds upon completion of the project or purposes for which the appropriations were made.".
