for

1 AN ACT relating to professions and occupations; amending
2 and repealing audit requirements; applying uniform
3 licensure board compensation to the Wyoming state board of
4 funeral service practitioners; and providing for an
5 effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 33-1-302(a)(iv)(intro), (A), (C), by
10 creating a new subparagraph (D) and (v) and 33-16-507 are
11 amended to read:

13 **33-1-302. Duties of licensure boards.**

14

15 (a) Except as otherwise specifically provided by
16 statute, a board authorized to establish examination,

1 inspection, permit or license fees for any profession or
2 occupation regulated under this title or under W.S.
3 11-25-105, 21-2-802 or 23-2-414 shall:

4
5 (iv) Require adequate internal control
6 structures to ensure the processing and accounting of all
7 financial transactions and, at a minimum, conduct periodic
8 audits of internal controls and ~~receipts to~~ financial
9 transactions. Periodic audits conducted under this
10 paragraph may be performed by the department of audit or an
11 independent audit firm retained by the board. The audits
12 shall be performed at intervals as designated by the
13 department of audit in consultation with the board. The
14 audit shall determine:

15
16 (A) Whether expenditures are made for the
17 benefit of the state; ~~in administration or operation of the~~
18 ~~law and applicable rules and regulations;~~

20 (C) Whether ~~the entity has complied with~~
21 ~~applicable laws and regulations.~~ expenditures are made in
22 compliance with applicable statutes, rules and regulations
23 which govern the specific board or profession; and

(D) Whether revenue transactions and cash handling procedures are reasonable for the volume and manner in which revenues are received.

(v) Provide a copy of the audit required by paragraph (iv) of this subsection to the department of audit, the state auditor and the legislative service office. In the event the audit was conducted by the department of audit, a copy of the audit shall be retained by the department of audit and a copy shall be provided to the state auditor and the legislative service office;

33-16-507. Compensation of board members.

The members of the board shall receive mileage and per diem allowance ~~as allowed to state employees~~ as provided in W.S. 33-1-302(a)(vii) when engaged in performing their duties as members of the board.

Section 2. W.S. 33-1-302(a)(iv)(B) is repealed.
