A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the military department; extending the
2 sunset date for the Wyoming national guard youth challenge
3 program; amending provisions controlling the expenditure of
4 appropriated funds; providing an appropriation; and
5 providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 19-9-702 and 19-9-704 are amended to
10 read:

12 **19-9-702. Funding.**

13

14 To the extent available, for every ~~sixty cents (\$.60)~~ forty
15 cents (\$.40) of federal funds appropriated to the national

1 guard youth challenge program, the department may expend
2 funds appropriated by this state for this program in an
3 amount not to exceed ~~forty cents (\$.40)~~ sixty cents (\$.60),
4 or such other minimum amount as necessary to qualify for
5 the appropriation of federal funds. The state may
6 appropriate funding in excess of that necessary to qualify
7 for federal funds and the department shall be authorized to
8 expend such state funds only when all federal funds are
9 exhausted. All monies appropriated for purposes of this
10 article are continuously appropriated to the department and
11 shall not lapse until the program is terminated as provided
12 by W.S. 19-9-704.

14 **19-9-704. Sunset.**

15

16 W.S. 19-9-701 through 19-9-703 are repealed effective June
17 30, ~~2017~~ 2025.

19 **Section 2.** There is appropriated two million five
20 hundred ten thousand four hundred eight dollars
21 (\$2,510,408.00) from the school foundation fund and one
22 million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000.00) in

1 federal funds to the Wyoming military department for the
2 national guard youth challenge program.

4 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2016.
