6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 18-12-102(a)(ix), 18-12-103(a)(iii)
9 and 18-12-112(a) by creating a new paragraph (xxii) are
10 amended to read:

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12 **18-12-102. Definitions.**

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14 (a) As used in this act:

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1 (ix) "Service" means:

3 (A) The operation and maintenance of
4 improvements and any other service authorized by this act;
5 or

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7 (B) The provision of emergency medical
8 services.

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10 **18-12-103. Districts authorized; general function.**

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12 (a) Any unincorporated territory in this state may be
13 formed into an improvement and service district to perform
14 any of the following functions:

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16 (iii) Furnish or perform any special local
17 service which enhances the use or enjoyment of any
18 improvement or facility or enhances the provision of
19 emergency medical services.

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21 **18-12-112. Powers of district.**

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23 (a) Each district may:

1

2 (xxii) Provide emergency medical services, enter
3 into agreements with any public or private agency,
4 institution or person for the furnishing of emergency
5 medical services and establish and collect charges for
6 emergency medical services, including authority to change
7 the amount or rate thereof, and to pledge the revenues
8 therefrom for the payment of district indebtedness.

10 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2016.
