Catch Title: Energy producing states coalition extension.

Subject: Extension of the State's participation in the Energy Producing States Coalition

Summary/Major Elements:

- In 2011, Wyoming joined the Energy Producing States Coalition, a collection of states with strong energy industries. The goals of the Coalition are to: (1) encourage domestic development of energy; (2) deliver a strong, unified voice to the federal government from states that produce energy; and (3) eliminate or reduce overreaching federal legislation and identify and address consequences that result from delays and cancellations of economically viable energy projects.
- This act extends the participation of Wyoming legislators in the Energy Producing States Coalition. The act specifies how legislators are appointed and provides an appropriation for legislators attending Coalition meetings.

Comments:

- Requires a report: The act requires appointed legislators to submit a report to Management Council on before October 1 of each year.

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
