Catch Title: Cease and transfer program local government funding.

Subject: Provides grants and loans for the total cost of a project under the Municipal Solid Waste Facilities Cease and Transfer Program.

Summary/Major Elements:

- The Municipal Solid Waste Facilities Cease and Transfer Program provides grants and loans for solid waste projects such as capping closed landfills or acquiring new solid waste facilities and equipment. Currently, W.S. 35-11-528 allows the State Loan and Investment Board to provide grants and loans of up to seventy-five percent (75%) of a project's costs.
- This act allows the State Loan and Investment Board, upon recommendation by the Director of the Department of Environmental Quality, to issue grants and loans totaling up to one hundred percent (100%) of total project costs to operators of solid waste facilities who have exhausted other funding sources.

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
