Catch Title: Concealed weapons-military applicant.

Subject: Concealed weapons permit for military applicants outside the state

Summary/Major Elements:

- Current Wyoming law requires applicants for a concealed weapons permit to complete an application under oath and submit the application to the sheriff's office in the county of the applicant's residence.
- This bill provides a procedure for applicants in military service outside the state to apply for a concealed weapons permit without coming to the state, provided that the applicant:
 - Submits proof of Wyoming residency, a certification of the applicant's active military service outside the state and a notarized affidavit testifying in writing that the statements in the application are true and accurate; and
 - Otherwise meets applicable requirements under statute for applying for a concealed weapons permit.
- This bill requires the Attorney General to promulgate rules and regulations necessary to implement the act.

Comments:

- That portion of the bill requiring rules by the Attorney General is effective immediately in order to allow the rules to be promulgated before a July 1, 2016, deadline. The remainder of the bill is effective July 1, 2016.
