Catch Title: Juvenile detention facility-definition.

Subject: Definition of juvenile detention facility

Summary/Major Elements:

- Existing law defines “juvenile detention facility” to include any facility which may legally and physically restrict and house a child, other than the Wyoming Boys’ School, the Wyoming Girls’ School, the Wyoming State Hospital, or other private or public psychiatric facility within the State.
- This bill specifies that “juvenile detention facility” does not include any residential treatment facility which is operated for the primary purpose of providing treatment to a child.

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
