Catch Title: Controlled substances-disposal.

Subject: Disposal of controlled substances in accordance with applicable federal regulations

Summary/Major Elements:

- This act:
 - o Authorizes a person to collect a controlled substance of a decedent for purposes of disposal in accordance with specified federal regulations.
 - o Exempts from the provisions and penalties of the Wyoming Controlled Substances Act of 1971, persons in possession of a controlled substance for purposes of disposal in accordance with specified federal regulations.
 - o Requires any Drug Drop Off and Disposal Program established by the Department of Health to be in compliance with applicable federal law.
- Existing law provides immunity from civil or criminal liability or professional disciplinary action for specified acts to persons who participate in donating, accepting, distributing or dispensing drugs under the Drug Donation Program Act. This act extends that immunity to persons acting in accordance with federal law.
