Catch Title: Gray wolves and grizzly bears.

Subject: Removal of gray wolves and grizzly bears from listing under the Endangered Species Act

Summary/Major Elements:

- This joint resolution requests that Congress and the United States Fish and Wildlife Services seek removal of gray wolf and grizzly bear populations from the list of experimental nonessential populations, endangered species or threatened species in Wyoming.
- This joint resolution calls on Congress to:
 - Fund necessary programs and services for gray wolf and grizzly bear management, particularly those that compensate individuals and entities for losses caused by these species; and
 - Assist in funding necessary programs and services for gray wolf and grizzly bear management after the date the species are removed from the list of experimental nonessential populations, endangered species or threatened species in Wyoming.
