Catch Title: Military service member protections.

Subject: Amends the Military Service Relief Act to include members of the uniformed services of any state who work in Wyoming

Summary/Major Elements:

- Under current law, any member of the Wyoming National Guard or the United States military forces reserve who works in Wyoming is granted certain employment rights under the Military Service Relief Act.
- This act specifies that members of the uniformed service of any state who work in Wyoming are eligible for the same employment rights as members of the Wyoming uniformed services.

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
