Catch Title: Data management policies.

Subject: Policies on the collection, access, security and use of data

Summary/Major Elements:

- This bill requires state agencies to adopt, enforce and maintain a policy regarding the collection, access, security and use of data. This bill specifies that State agencies' policies shall adhere to standards set by the State Chief Information Officer and shall include specified information.
- This bill defines "agency" as any office, department, board, commission, council, institution, separate operating agency or any other operating unit of the Executive Branch of State government but not the Legislature, judiciary, University of Wyoming or community colleges.
- This bill requires the State Chief Information Officer to:
 - Develop guidelines for the collection, access, security and use of data by counties, cities, towns and other political subdivisions, other than any community college district or school district within the State; and
 - Report the recommended guidelines to the Task Force on Digital Information Privacy by September 1, 2016.

Comments:

- Requires a report to the Task Force on Digital Information Privacy.
