Catch Title: Obsolete statutory language-health care.

Subject: Correcting and clarifying obsolete statutory language regarding health care

Summary/Major Elements:

- This bill repeals and amends various obsolete statutory provisions regarding health care by correcting names, deleting outdated references, conforming language to current practices and updating statutory references.
- The bill removes “attendant certificate” language within the emergency medical technician licensing statutes and replaces it with language referring to emergency medical technician licenses. The bill provides for the suspension of EMT licenses upon the nonpayment of child support, provides for temporary emergency medical technician licensure in the event of an emergency, and amends provisions related to licensing fees and license expiration dates.
- The bill amends the newborn metabolic screening program by removing specific timelines for screening.
- The bill repeals provisions related to:
 - o The Department of Health’s Advisory Council;
 - o The regulation of clinical laboratories and blood banks; and
 - o Misplaced statutory provisions regarding license restrictions.
