Catch Title: Juvenile sex offender-risk assessment.

Subject: Assessment of juvenile sex offenders and notification requirements

Summary/Major Elements:

- This act requires district attorneys, if public safety requires, to request a hearing for a determination of risk of re-offense for juvenile sex offenders.
- The act creates criteria for a court to use to determine the risk of re-offense.
- For low risk offenders, the bill provides for notice of the offender's presence to persons authorized to receive criminal history records.
- For moderate or high risk offenders, the act provides for notice of the offender's presence to residents who live within 750 feet of the offender's residence, to community organizations, and to those authorized to receive criminal history records as provided by court order.
