Catch Title: Homemade beverages.
Subject: Production and events related to homemade beverages

Summary/Major Elements:

- This bill authorizes holders of various liquor licenses to conduct organized tastings, exhibitions, contests and competitions of homemade beers, meads, wines and fermented fruit juices.
- The bill clarifies that no manufacturer's license is required for the production of homemade beer, mead, wine and fermented fruit juices in an amount less than two hundred gallons per household. The limit is one hundred gallons for a household with only one person over twenty-one years of age.
- The bill specifies that its provisions apply only to homemade beers, meads, wines or fermented fruit juices provided without financial consideration. The bill defines the term "financial consideration" and makes clear that financial consideration does not include an event admission charge, cover charge or dues, the amount of which is independent of the amount of beer, mead, wine or fermented fruit juice to be provided or consumed.

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
