**Catch Title:** Off-road recreational vehicles.

**Subject:** Recreational vehicle trails on public road rights-of-way

**Summary/Major Elements:**

- Under current Wyoming law, streets, roads and highways may be designated as off-road recreational vehicle trails.
- This act specifically authorizes the designation of public road rights-of-way as off-road recreational vehicle trails, subject to conditions specified in statute. The act also specifies that it does not authorize expansion or acquisition of public road rights-of-way.
- This act defines “public road right-of-way” as the entire right-of-way of a street, road or highway, including the traveled portions, banks, ditches, shoulders and medians of a street, road or highway.

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
