Catch Title: Emergency medical services.

Subject: Allowing improvement and service districts to provide emergency medical services

Summary/Major Elements:

- This bill permits improvement and service districts to provide emergency medical services (EMS) to enter into agreements to furnish EMS, and to establish and collect charges for EMS. The revenues generated from any charge may be pledged to pay district indebtedness.
- The bill permits a county to levy an annual ad valorem tax, up to two mills, on property within the district to pay for EMS services the district provides within the county. A county may levy more than two mills, with a maximum of four, if approved by the board of directors and voters of the district.
