Catch Title: Public health laboratory fees.

Subject: Fees for laboratory testing services

Summary/Major Elements:

- This act authorizes the Department of Health (Department) to charge reasonable fees for laboratory testing services provided to other state agencies, local law enforcement entities and other individuals or organizations.
- This act specifies the fees shall be:
 - Established by rule or regulation;
 - Established in an amount sufficient to recoup the Department's cost of providing the laboratory testing services; and
 - Charged only if the Department makes personnel available to testify in criminal trials as to the Department's laboratory testing results.
- The act further specifies public health laboratory fees collected by the Department may be credited to a special revenue account.
