15 "(k) A ski area operator shall mark hydrants, water pipes
16 and all other man-made structures on slopes and trails which are
17 not readily visible to skiers under conditions of ordinary
18 visibility from a distance of one hundred (100) feet and shall
19 adequately and appropriately cover the structures with a shock-
20 absorbent material that will lessen injuries. Any type of marker
21 shall be sufficient under this subsection including but not
22 limited to wooden poles, flags or signs if the marker is visible
23 from a distance of one hundred (100) feet and if the marker
24 itself does not constitute a serious hazard to skiers. As used
25 in this subsection "man-made structures" shall not include
26 variations in steepness or terrain, whether natural or as a
27 result of slope design, snowmaking or grooming operations,
28 including but not limited to roads, catwalks and other terrain
29 modifications.

31 (m) Whenever maintenance equipment is being employed to
32 maintain or groom any ski slope or trail while the ski slope or
33 trail is open to the public, the ski area operator shall place
34 or cause to be placed a conspicuous notice to that effect at or
35 near the top of that ski slope or trail. This subsection shall
36 not apply to maintenance equipment transitioning to or from a
37 maintenance or grooming project."
