Page 1-line 11 Delete the Coe et al. Second Reading Amendment (SF0165S2003.02/AC) and the Coe et al. Second Reading Amendment (SF0165S2002.03/AC) to this line and further amend as follows: Delete "21-13-309(p)" insert "21-13-309(m)(v)(F) and by creating a new subparagraph (H), (p)".

Page 1-line 13 In the Scott Second Reading Amendment (SF0165S2002/A) to this line after "21-13-321(b)" insert "and by creating a new subsection (h)".

Page 2-after line 18 Delete the Coe et al. Second Reading Amendment (SF0165S2003.02/AC) and the Coe et al. Second Reading Amendment (SF0165S2002.03/AC) to this line and further amend as follows: Insert:

"(m) In determining the amount to be included in the foundation program for each district, the state superintendent shall:

(v) Based upon ADM computations and identified school configurations within each district pursuant to paragraph (iv) of this subsection, compute the foundation program amount for each district as prescribed by the education resource block grant model adopted by the Wyoming legislature as defined under W.S. 21-13-101(a)(xiv), as contained within the spreadsheets and accompanying reports referenced under W.S. 21-13-101(a)(xvii), on file with the secretary of state and maintained by the state superintendent pursuant to W.S. 21-2-202(e). The following criteria shall be used by the state superintendent in the administration of the education resource block grant model:

(F) Amounts provided within the model for health insurance shall be based upon:

(I) Except as provided in subdivision (III) of this subparagraph, prior year statewide average district weighted actual participation in district health insurance plans

13 (1) The amount for health insurance
14 shall be calculated on a reimbursement basis only for
15 individuals actually employed by the district and shall not be
16 paid with funds received pursuant to the foundation program
17 amount under W.S. 21-13-309(p) or funds received under W.S. 21-
18 13-334 or 21-13-335. The amount calculated shall be based upon
19 actual participation in district health insurance plans and
20 shall be based on the district's employer paid premium cost not
21 to exceed the annualized state contribution rate as of January
22 1, 2017, on behalf of each employee and official enrolled in the
23 state group health insurance plan, for employee only, split
24 contracts, employee plus spouse or children and family coverage,
25 as applies to the coverage of each district employee
26 participating in district health insurance plans;

28 (2) This subparagraph shall not apply
29 to health insurance amounts generated for employees funded as
30 special education employees, transportation employees, food
31 service employees or employees who are funded one hundred
32 percent (100%) with federal funds;

34 (3) Employees funded with less than
35 one hundred percent (100%) federal funds shall be calculated
36 based on the pro rata amount that the salary of each employee is
37 paid with foundation program funds or funds received under W.S.
38 21-13-334 or 21-13-335 and calculated as provided in this
39 subdivision.

41 (H) For school year 2018-2019 only, the amount
42 within the block grant model for core teachers and specialist
43 teachers as defined in "Attachment A" shall be reduced based
44 upon the actual number of core and specialist teachers employed
45 by the school district in school year 2016-2017 so that no
46 district shall receive funding for more core and specialist
47 teachers than were actually employed by the district in the

1 2016-2017 school year. This subparagraph shall not apply to
2 minimum teachers or any calculation for alternative schools or
3 small schools."
