A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to domestic relations; modifying residency
2 requirements for the granting of a divorce as specified;
3 and providing for an effective date.

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5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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7 **Section 1.** W.S. 20-2-107(a) is amended to read:

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9 **20-2-107. Residential requirements generally for**
10 **divorce.**

12 (a) No divorce shall be granted unless ~~the plaintiff~~
13 one of the parties has resided in this state for sixty (60)
14 days immediately preceding the time of filing the
15 complaint, or the marriage was solemnized in this state and

1 ~~the plaintiff~~ one of the parties has resided in this state
2 from the time of the marriage until the filing of the
3 complaint.

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5 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2017.
