Community college capital construction.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to community college facilities; providing
2 appropriations and authorizations for community college
3 capital construction for the biennium commencing July 1,
4 2016 and ending June 30, 2018; providing for conditions,
5 additional appropriations and authorizations and other
6 requirements related to prior community college capital
7 construction appropriations; and providing an effective
8 date.

10 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

12 **Section 1.**

13

14 (a) As used in this act:

15

1 (i) "Appropriation" means the authorizations
2 granted by the legislature under this act to make
3 expenditures from and to incur obligations against the
4 general and other funds as specified;

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6 (ii) "PR" means private funding sources.

8 **Section 2.**

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10 (a) The following sums of money are appropriated for
11 the capital construction projects specified.
12 Appropriations for these projects remain in effect until
13 the project is completed. Appropriated funds under this
14 section shall be expended only on the projects specified
15 and any unused funds remaining at project completion shall
16 revert to the accounts from which they were appropriated.
17 The amounts appropriated in this section are intended to
18 provide a maximum amount for each project and shall not be
19 construed to be an entitlement or guaranteed amount:

 26 the general fund in 2016 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 97, Section 3
 27 for this project are not available at the time the project proceeds to

1 bid. To the extent general funds become available for this project, the
2 appropriation of "Other Funds PR" in this section shall be reduced by
3 an amount equal to the amount of general funds that are available for
4 this project. General funds appropriated and available for this
5 project shall be expended to reimburse any appropriation of "Other
6 Funds PR" in this section expended for the project.

8 2. This appropriation shall only be expended if appropriations from
9 the strategic investments and projects account in 2016 Wyoming Session
10 Laws, Chapter 97, Section 7 for this project are not available at the
11 time the project proceeds to bid. To the extent appropriations from the
12 strategic investments and projects account become available for this
13 project, the appropriation of "Other Funds PR" in this section shall be
14 reduced by an amount equal to the amount of funds from the strategic
15 investments and projects account that are available for this project.
16 Appropriations from the strategic investments and projects account that
17 become available shall be expended to reimburse any appropriation of
18 "Other Funds PR" in this section expended for the project.

19
20 **Section 4.** This act is effective immediately upon
21 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
22 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
23 Constitution.
