3 legislative branch of state government; and providing for
4 an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** 2016 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 79,
9 sections 1, 6(b), 8(a) and 10(a) are amended to read:

11 **Section 1.** There is appropriated from the
12 general fund to the legislative service office
13 the following specified amounts, or as much
14 thereof as may be necessary, to pay the costs and
15 expenses of the Wyoming legislature through June
16 30, 2018:

9 1. Legislative laptop computers being replaced
10 shall be sold in accordance with Management
11 Council directives. Any proceeds received from
12 the sale of any laptop computer shall be
13 deposited into the general fund and are hereby
14 reappropriated to the legislative service office
15 to be used for the purchase of replacement laptop
16 computers and support systems.

18 **Section 6.** [New Legislator Training
19 Compensation].

21 (b) There is appropriated from the general
22 fund to the legislative service office ~~sixty-two~~
23 ~~thousand dollars (\$62,000.00)~~ ~~twenty~~ thousand

1 dollars (\$20,000.00) or as much thereof as may be
2 necessary for purposes of this section.

4 **Section 8.** [Special Contingency].

6 (a) There is appropriated ~~one hundred~~
7 ~~twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000.00)~~ two
8 hundred seventy-four thousand seven hundred
9 nineteen dollars (\$274,719.00) from the general
10 fund to the legislative service office to be
11 expended at the direction of the Management
12 Council for extraordinary expenses of the
13 legislature and as necessary to supplement any
14 expense category under section 1 of this act.

16 **Section 10.** [Economic Development
17 Authorized Travel].

18
19 (a) There is appropriated ~~fifty thousand~~
20 ~~dollars (\$50,000.00)~~ forty-six thousand dollars
21 (\$46,000.00) from the general fund to the
22 legislative service office for legislative travel
23 expenses as authorized in this section.

1 **Section 11.** There is appropriated ~~forty-two~~
2 ~~thousand dollars (\$42,000.00)~~ twenty-one thousand
3 dollars (\$21,000.00) from the general fund to the
4 legislative service office for payment of
5 registration, mileage and per diem for
6 legislators attending the Wyoming state
7 treasurer's investment conference in the 2016 or
8 2017 interim. Registration payments shall not
9 exceed three hundred fifty dollars (\$350.00) per
10 legislator.

12 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
13 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
14 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
15 Constitution.
