A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the regulation of traffic on highways;
2 providing the department of transportation rulemaking
3 authority relating to lights of a conspicuous color on
4 municipal and county snow plows; and providing for an
5 effective date.

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7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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9 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-5-928(d) is amended to read:

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11 **31-5-928. General lighting restrictions; authorized**
12 **emergency vehicles.**

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14 (d) Every authorized emergency vehicle, except police
15 vehicles and as otherwise specified in this subsection,

1 shall, in addition to any other equipment required by law,
2 be equipped with at least one (1) red lamp visible from
3 five hundred (500) feet in front of the vehicle. Except as
4 otherwise provided in this subsection, every authorized
5 emergency vehicle, may be equipped with one (1) or more
6 blue, white or amber lights. Vehicles used by a
7 municipality, county or the department to clear snow from
8 public streets or highways may be equipped with one (1) or
9 more lights of a conspicuous color as specified by rules
10 adopted by the department. Privately-owned vehicles used
11 by members of a fire department or emergency service
12 organization in performing or traveling to perform assigned
13 duties in those organizations shall display at least one
14 (1) flashing white, red or amber light, but no blue lights,
15 visible from five hundred (500) feet in front of the
16 vehicle.

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18 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
19 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
20 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
21 Constitution.
