Graduation requirement-CPR.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to education; requiring students to
2 complete instruction on emergency medical treatment to
3 graduate high school; requiring school districts to offer
4 that instruction; requiring rulemaking; providing
5 applicability; and providing for an effective date.

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7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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9 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-9-101 by creating a new subsection
10 (h) is amended to read:

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12 **21-9-101. Educational programs for schools;**
13 **standards; core of knowledge and skills; special needs**
14 **programs; class size requirements; cocurricular activities.**

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1 (h) Not later than the 2018-2019 school year, all
2 school districts shall provide instruction in
3 cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) in accordance with
4 standards promulgated by the state board. The standards
5 shall require at a minimum that the instruction follows
6 nationally recognized guidelines for psychomotor
7 cardiopulmonary resuscitation skills training. Students
8 shall be given an opportunity to practice and master CPR
9 and shall be instructed in the use of an automated external
10 defibrillator. No student shall receive a high school
11 diploma from a public high school without successfully
12 completing a course in CPR required under this section.

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14 **Section 2.** This act shall apply to students
15 graduating high school on or after January 1, 2020.

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17 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2017.
