A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming tobacco settlement fund;
2 clarifying the authorized purposes for disclosure of
3 information to the attorney general; authorizing disclosure
4 of information to enable compliance with a settlement
5 agreement; and providing for an effective date.

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7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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9 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-4-1207(b) is amended to read:

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11 **9-4-1207. Reporting of information; escrow**
12 **installments.**

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14 (b) The department is authorized to disclose to the
15 attorney general any information received under this act

1 and requested by the attorney general for purposes of
2 determining compliance with and enforcing the provisions of
3 this act, implementing the master settlement agreement as
4 defined in W.S. 9-4-1201(a)(v) or resolving any dispute
5 arising under the master settlement agreement. The
6 director of the department and the attorney general shall
7 share the information received under this act and may share
8 the information with other federal, state or local agencies
9 or with a data clearinghouse or any similar entity or
10 process established under the master settlement agreement
11 or a settlement of any dispute arising under that
12 agreement, only for the purposes of enforcement of this
13 act, W.S. 9-4-1202, ~~or~~ enforcement of corresponding laws of
14 other states or implementation of the master settlement
15 agreement or a settlement of any dispute arising under that
16 agreement.

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18 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2017.
