Obsolete reporting requirements-repeal and modification.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to government record keeping and reporting;
2 amending and repealing local child protection agency
3 reporting and record keeping obligations; amending and
4 repealing department of family services reporting and
5 record keeping obligations; amending the governor's
6 obligation to require annual program plans from human
7 service agencies; amending state agency plan reporting
8 requirements; and providing for an effective date.

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10 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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12 **Section** **1.** W.S. 9-1-204(b)(intro),
13 28-1-115(a)(ii)(intro) and (C) and 42-2-109(a)(intro) are
14 amended to read:

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16 **9-1-204. Human services agencies.**

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2 (b) In order to coordinate policy planning for all
3 state human services agencies, the governor ~~shall~~may
4 require:

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6 **28-1-115. Submission of state agency plans to**
7 **legislature; contents; purposes.**

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9 (a) To assist the legislature in its deliberations,
10 every state agency shall:

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12 (ii) ~~On or before September 1 of each odd~~
13 ~~numbered year, following an opportunity for public review,~~
14 ~~submit to and have approved by the governor a four (4) year~~
15 ~~plan covering the period beginning July 1 of the following~~
16 ~~year and ending June 30 in the fourth succeeding year, As~~
17 ~~required by the governor or by the legislature in a budget~~
18 ~~bill or other enactment, develop a multi-year plan~~ to
19 accomplish and further the goals and objectives defined in
20 W.S. 28-1-116(a). ~~The plan development shall include an~~
21 ~~opportunity for public review and comment. The plan shall~~
22 ~~be submitted to the governor for his approval.~~ The plan

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10 (a) Public assistance and social services provided

11 under this article shall be reviewed at least once each

12 year, except for recipients enrolled in an approved

13 educational program which shall be reviewed once every six

14 (6) months. An approved educational program under this

15 section shall be limited to educational courses not to

16 exceed the baccalaureate degree level. After review, the

17 department may continue, modify or terminate public

18 assistance and social services in accordance with the

19 circumstances of the recipient and the provisions of this

11 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
12 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
13 Constitution.
