Catch Title: Obsolete laws.

Subject: Cleanup of outdated and archaic laws in the Wyoming statutes.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This bill is part of the Legislature's regular effort to update statutes which have been ruled unconstitutional, which have reached their sunset date, which contain incorrect citations or which are otherwise outdated or archaic.
- This bill:
 - Repeals provisions granting immunity to governmental entities for year 2000 computer date failures;
 - Removes references to repealed portions of the simple assault and simple battery statutes;
 - Amends a reference to a repealed statutory provision regarding state funded capital construction projects;
 - Amends a reference to a repealed statutory provision regarding a Game and Fish fee license schedule;
 - Amends references to the "department of employment" to indicate the "department of workforce services";
 - Repeals obsolete provisions for staggered vehicle registration in the year 1990;
 - Repeals provisions for sales and use tax exemptions on electricity produced through renewable resources that expired in the year 2012.
