**Catch Title:** Education-resident tuition reimbursement.

**Subject:** Funding for resident students attending school out-of-state.

**Summary/Major Elements:**

- This bill modifies the timing of payments to a school district with resident students attending school out-of-state.
- The school district will be reimbursed from the school foundation program account for the full amount of tuition assessed by the out-of-state district.
- The school district must submit to the Department of Education a report verifying payments to the out-of-state district and documenting the number of pupils attending the out-of-state district.
- The Department must distribute payments to eligible school districts on or before May 15 of the applicable school year, together with foundation program payments.
