Catch Title: Board of professional engineers and land surveyors.

Subject: Board of professional engineers and land surveyors.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This act reduces the number of members of the Board of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors (Board) required to constitute a quorum from six (6) to five (5).
- The act allows for persons who have not graduated from a doctoral curriculum but who have graduated from a curriculum approved by the Board of at least 4 years and who have been actively engaged in engineering practice of a character satisfactory to the Board for at least 10 years after graduation to apply for a license as a professional engineer.
- Existing law establishes qualifications for applicants to receive a license to practice professional engineering or professional land surveying based on comity, including that the applicant has not been disciplined by another jurisdiction. This act modifies that language to require the applicant is of good moral character and repute.
- Existing law authorizes the Board to issue subpoenas for the production of evidence in disciplinary proceedings. This act specifies that the Board may subpoena books, records, electronic records, documents and other evidence the Board deems relevant to an investigation or hearing.
- The act applies to applications for licensure filed with the Board on or after July 1, 2017.
