Catch Title: Concealed weapons-military family applicants.

Subject: Concealed weapons permit for military spouses outside the state.

Summary/Major Elements:

- Current law provides a procedure for a person in military service outside the state to apply for a concealed weapons permit without coming to the state.
- This act authorizes a person who is a military spouse residing with a person in active military service outside the state to use that procedure to apply for a concealed weapons permit without coming to the state.
- The act also requires the Attorney General to define military spouse and specifies that a military spouse applying for a concealed weapons permit shall include proof of marriage to the person in active military service.

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
