Catch Title: Payment of wages upon termination-time limits.

Subject: Establishes the date for the payment of wages to an employee who quits or is discharged where the employee has a collective bargaining agreement.

Summary/Major Elements:

- The bill requires that an employee who has a collective bargaining agreement with an employer must receive, upon quitting or being terminated, any wages owed to him at the time specified in the agreement.
- If no collective bargaining agreement specifies a payment date, the employee must receive any wages owed to him no later than the next regularly scheduled payroll date.

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
