Catch Title: Tribal license plates.

Subject: Eastern Shoshone Indian tribe and Northern Arapaho Indian tribe specialty license plates contributing to scholarship funding for students at the University of Wyoming.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This bill allows for the creation and sale of Eastern Shoshone Indian Tribe and Northern Arapaho Indian Tribe license plates for any motor vehicle that is not a commercial or multipurpose vehicle.
- The Department of Transportation and the business council of each tribe will work together to design each Tribe's license plate.
- The bill establishes a \$70.00 application fee, payable to the University of Wyoming. The fee must be deposited in equal amounts to the Chief Washakie Memorial Endowment Fund and the Northern Arapaho Endowment Fund for the purpose of funding scholarships for students at the University of Wyoming.

Comments:

- The bill requires a report to the Legislature on or before January 15, 2027, if production of the specialty plates has ceased because fewer than 500 sets of license plates are issued before December 31, 2025.
- This bill is effective January 1, 2018.
