**Catch Title:** Motor vehicle insurance-penalties.

**Subject:** Penalties-Motor Vehicle Insurance.

**Summary/Major Elements:**

- Under existing law, the fine for failing to maintain liability coverage for a motor vehicle is \$250 to \$750 for the first violation. The fine for a second or subsequent violation is \$500 to \$1,500.
- This bill would create one fine range for failing to maintain liability coverage for a motor vehicle: \$500 to \$1,500.

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
