Catch Title: Study on evaluation requirements for small cities and towns.

Subject: Study on evaluation requirements for small cities and towns.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This bill requires the Department of Audit to provide a report on the audit requirements for small cities and towns of less than four thousand (4,000) inhabitants.
- The bill requires the report to include the most recent evaluation of small cities and towns pursuant to statutory requirements. The report must also include recommendations related to changes to the evaluation of cities and towns as well as changes to the bookkeeping and financial reporting methods for small cities and towns.

Comments:

- The Department of Audit is required to provide the report described above, including any recommendations for legislation, to the Joint Corporations, Elections and Political Subdivisions Interim Committee not later than October 1, 2017. The bill requires the Joint Corporations, Elections and Political Subdivisions Interim Committee to consider the report and develop any legislation it deems appropriate for consideration by the Legislature.
