Catch Title: Game and fish fees.

Subject: Increases fees relating to game and fish licenses, preference points, permits, applications and stamps.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This act increases the following fees relating to game and fish licenses, preference points, permits, applications and stamps to the specified amount:
 - Duplicate licenses - \$5
 - Nonresident application fee - \$15
 - Nonresident elk license special drawing fee - \$576
 - Nonresident deer license special drawing fee - \$288
 - Nonresident antelope license special drawing fee - \$288
 - Resident black bear license - \$45
 - Nonresident black bear license - \$371
 - Resident mountain lion license - \$30
 - Nonresident mountain lion license - \$371
 - Nonresident daily game bird/small game license - \$20
 - Resident lifetime game bird and small game license - \$309
 - Resident lifetime game bird/small game and fishing license - \$494
 - Resident game bird/small game license - \$25
 - Nonresident game bird/small game license - \$72
 - Nonresident archery license - \$70
 - Resident deer license - \$40
 - Nonresident deer license - \$372
 - Resident elk license - \$55
 - Nonresident elk license - \$690

 - Nonresident wild bison license - \$4,400 or \$2,750 (female or calf)
 - Resident fishing license - \$25
 - Nonresident fishing license - \$100
 - Resident lifetime fishing license - \$309
 - Resident trapping license-furbearing - \$43
 - License to capture furbearing animals - \$19
 - Resident fur dealer's license - \$52
 - Nonresident fur dealer's license - \$283
 - Taxidermist's license - \$67
 - Nonresident taxidermist's license - \$721
 - Game bird farm license - \$134
 - Fishing preserve license - \$134
 - Commercial fish hatchery license - \$185
 - License to seine or trap fish - \$19
 - License to deal in live bait - \$67
 - Nonresident trapping license-furbearing - \$247
 - Lifetime conservation stamp - \$185
 - Special management permit - \$15
 - Duplicate watercraft certificate – not more than \$10
 - Testing/demonstrating motorboats certificate - \$30
 - Motorboat registration - \$30 (1 year) or \$80 (3 years)
- The act also repeals the provision authorizing the Game and Fish Commission to promulgate rules providing for a nonrefundable entry fee (minimum of \$6) for the drawing of a wild bison license.
