Catch Title: Legislative employees.

Subject: Specifies authority of the Legislature to employ session staff.

Summary/Major Elements:

- Current law provides for each body of the Legislature to employ staff during the session. Historically some session staff have been employed shortly before and after the session to prepare for the session and wrap things up.
- This bill specifies that each body may employ staff beyond the adjournment of the session to complete recordkeeping and before session to prepare for sessions.
- Staff are employed under the direction of the presiding officers.
- The bill also specifies that all persons employed by either house at all times serve at the will of the presiding officer of each house.

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
