Catch Title: Veteran license plate stickers-repeal.

Subject: Veteran license plate sticker.

Summary/Major Elements:

- Under current law, the Wyoming Veterans Commission is authorized to sell veteran license plate stickers to qualified veterans. Since 2010, pursuant to 2009 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 179, veterans have also had the option to purchase specialty armed forces license plates and sales of stickers have subsequently declined.
- This bill repeals provisions authorizing the veteran license plate sticker. This bill also provides that veteran license stickers sold before July 1, 2017, shall not be considered foreign material on a license plate, which would otherwise be prohibited.

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
