Catch Title: Military department recordkeeping.

Subject: Recordkeeping requirements for the Military Department.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This act revises the Military Department's recordkeeping responsibilities.
- The act requires the Adjutant General of Wyoming to maintain electronic access to all current orders, rules and regulations prescribed by the Secretary of Defense and the Department of Defense for the National Guard.
- The act requires the Adjutant General to keep records of past and present Wyoming National Guard personnel and veterans who declare Wyoming as their residence upon separation from the military.
- The act allows for the disposal of military records when the Adjutant General has authority to do so.
- The act allows the Adjutant General to delegate these responsibilities to the Veterans' Commission.

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
