Catch Title: Enterprise technology services amendments.

Subject: Codification of historic ETS budget bill provisions.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This Act places into statute provisions related to the Department of Enterprise Technology Services (“ETS”) which were previously placed in the general appropriations bill. Those provisions include:
 - All computer purchases made under the Chief Information Officer’s State Technology Replacement Program are to be made pursuant to standardized pricing and funds appropriated for computer acquisition shall only be spent on computer acquisitions;
 - Requires ETS to apply to the Universal Service Administrative Company under the Federal Communications Commission for the schools and libraries program of the Universal Service Fund. Funds received under this program shall be deposited in the School Foundation Program Account;
 - Provides that ETS shall purchase services from commercial communications carriers to the fullest extent reasonably feasible for use in the state government's telecommunications network (known as the “Unified Network”); and
 - Restricts use of the Unified Network to only the State of Wyoming and its entities, the University of Wyoming, community colleges, public schools and public libraries. Political subdivisions of the State of Wyoming are not authorized to use the Unified Network.
