Catch Title: Liquor dispensing rooms.
Subject: Liquor dispensing rooms.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This act removes the restriction and related fee on the number of dispensing rooms in which alcoholic and malt beverages may be sold and generally provides for the sale of alcoholic and malt beverages anywhere in a licensed building. This bill does not change existing law limiting the dispensing of alcoholic and malt beverages in restaurants to one room, except that a local licensing authority may approve dispensing in one additional room in a restaurant.
- The act repeals temporary permits for licensees to sell alcoholic or malt beverages in additional dispensing rooms.
- The act authorizes clubs holding a limited retail license to sell alcoholic or malt beverages for consumption anywhere on their licensed premises when approved by the local licensing authority.
- The act creates an offense for underage persons who enter or remain in establishments that are primarily for off-premise sales of alcoholic or malt beverages unless accompanied by a parent, spouse or legal guardian who is 21 years of age or older.
- The act repeals restrictions on minors in dispensing rooms where alcoholic or malt beverages are sold.
